CONSOLIDATED ELECTION

APRIL 4, 2017

Petitions for Plainfield **Village President and Village Trustee** will be available for pick up starting on Tuesday, September 20, 2016. Petitions can be picked up at the Plainfield Village Hall, 24401 W. Lockport Street, Plainfield, Illinois, in the Village Clerk's office, Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

Petitions must be filed with the Village Clerk:

First day to file – December 12, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.

Last day to file – December 19, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.

Vacant Open Positions:

Village President – 4 year team
Three (3) Trustee Positions – 4 year term

Requirements:

- **Residency:** One year of residency in the municipality preceding the Consolidated Election.
- **Statement of Candidacy:** Must be filed with nominating petitions.
- **Signature Requirements for Nominating Petition Sheets:** For the Consolidated Election, not less than 5% nor more than 8% (or 50 more than the minimum, whichever is greater) of the number of persons who voted at the last regular election in the district (1,736). Candidates name for placement on the ballot will be taken from the first numbered page of nominating petitions.
- **Statement of Economic Interest:** Must be filed with the Will County Clerk, 302 N. Chicago Street, Joliet, IL 60432. A receipt of filing of the Statement of Economic Interest **MUST** be filed with the Village Clerk with the nominating papers or before the last day of filing, December 19, 2016.
- **Loyalty Oath:** Must be filed with nominating papers. (Optional)
- **Campaign Financing Disclosure:** Must be filed with the State Board of Elections and the County Clerk.
- **Fair Campaign Practices Act:** Must be filed with the County Clerk. (Voluntary)
- **Term Begins:** Shall commence at the first regular meeting of the corporate authorities in the month of May following such election.
- **Term of Office:** 4 years.
