Re: 2020 Non-MFT and MFT Street Improvement Programs

The Village's 2020 Street Improvement Programs are underway with work scheduled to be completed in the following subdivisions and locations this summer: **Vintage Knoll Drive, Castle Meadows (Ash St/Maple Ct), Fairfield Commons (Fairfield Dr), Renwick Road east of Drauden Rd, Drauden Road north of Renwick Rd, Indian Oaks, Eagle Chase, The Enclave, Bronk Estates, Marybrook, Century Trace west of 248th Avenue, and 119th Street west of Normantown Road.** The general scope of work and order of construction activities included in the project is the removal and replacement of selected areas of concrete sidewalk, installation of new concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter removal and replacement, drainage improvements, pavement grinding, and resurfacing and pavement striping. Overall project completion is scheduled for October.

The following is an update of completed activities and tentative schedule for future work (weather permitting):

Fairfield Drive:	All work is complete.
Renwick Rd/Drauden Rd:	All work is complete.
Indian Oaks:	All work is complete.
Vintage Knoll	All work is complete.
Ash St/Maple Ct:	Concrete and asphalt pavement work have been completed. Pavement markings and new traffic signs will be installed.
Marybrook:	All work is completed. Crews will take care of punch list items over the next few weeks.
Eagle Chase:	Concrete and asphalt pavement work have been completed. Pavement markings and new traffic signs will be installed.
The Enclave:	Concrete and asphalt pavement work have been completed. Pavement markings and new traffic signs will be installed.
Bronk Estates:	Concrete and asphalt pavement work have been completed. Pavement markings and new traffic signs will be installed.

Century Trace and 119th St:

Concrete work is complete. Asphalt grinding is expected to be completed the week of September 28. New asphalt pavement is expected to begin October 2 and be completed the week of October 5. Pavement markings and new traffic signs are scheduled to be installed after the asphalt pavement has been completed.
